9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the J.D. McCarty Center for  
11 Children with Developmental Disabilities; making an  
12 appropriation to the J.D. McCarty Center for Children  
13 with Developmental Disabilities; stating purpose;  
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
15 requiring compliance with and providing budgetary  
16 limitations; providing lapse dates; requiring and  
17 prohibiting certain budget procedures; providing an  
18 effective date.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the J.D. McCarty  
21 Center for Children with Developmental Disabilities from any monies  
22 not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the  
23 State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the sum of  
24 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary  
to perform the duties imposed upon the J.D. McCarty Center for  
Children with Developmental Disabilities by law.

1 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
2 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
3 upon the J.D. McCarty Center for Children with Developmental  
4 Disabilities by law shall be set by the J.D. McCarty Center for  
5 Children with Developmental Disabilities. The J.D. McCarty Center  
6 for Children with Developmental Disabilities for the fiscal year  
7 ending June 30, 2014, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
8 limitations, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions  
9 of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

12 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the J.D.  
13 McCarty Center for Children with Developmental Disabilities shall  
14 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

17 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
18 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
19 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 (hereafter FY-14) or may be  
20 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 (hereafter FY-15).  
21 Funds budgeted for FY-14 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
22 2014, and must be expended by November 15, 2014. Any funds  
23 remaining after November 15, 2014, and not budgeted for FY-15, shall  
24 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal

1 year. Funds budgeted for FY-15 may be encumbered only through June  
2 30, 2015. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2015, shall lapse  
3 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
4 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
5 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-14, and not required to pay  
6 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-15, after  
7 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
8 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
9 from the FY-14 budget work program and after such revision has been  
10 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

11 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.

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
