9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
11 Investigation; making an appropriation; stating
12 purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories
13 and amounts; providing for the duties and
14 compensation of employees; limiting salary of the
15 Director; providing budgetary limitations;
16 authorizing transfer of funds to an agency special
17 account for certain purposes; limiting amount
18 authorized to be transferred; requiring certain
19 report; specifying duties for certain full-time-
20 equivalent employees; making their employment
21 contingent on certain funding; authorizing exemption
22 of certain federal funds from expenditure
23 limitations; specifying how funds will be used;
24 providing lapse dates; requiring and prohibiting
certain budget practices; and providing an effective
date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State
23 Bureau of Investigation from any monies not otherwise appropriated
24 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal

1 year ending June 30, 2014, the sum of _____ Dollars
2 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
3 imposed upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation by law.

4 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the
5 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall budget all funds in the
6 following categories and amounts:

14 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
15 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
16 upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation by law shall be set
17 by the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation. The
18 salary of the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation
19 shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable
20 monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014. The Oklahoma
21 State Bureau of Investigation for the fiscal year ending June 30,
22 2014, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
23 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
24 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be

1 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
2 the Oklahoma Statutes:

6 Full-time equivalent employees solely paid by grant funds shall not
7 count against the agency's budgetary limitations as specified in
8 this section.

9 SECTION 4. Of the amount appropriated to the Oklahoma State
10 Bureau of Investigation by Section 1 of this act, a maximum of
11 Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) may be transferred to an
12 agency special account for the purpose of purchasing evidence items,
13 paying fees to informers or special employees, paying expenses
14 incurred in the prosecution and defense of civil actions, and paying
15 other expenses as incurred under the Evidence Fund activity in
16 trying to apprehend and convict violators of the laws of the state.
17 The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall report income to
18 the Evidence Fund annually pursuant to the provisions of Sections
19 34.42 and 34.36 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

20 SECTION 5. Of the total number of full-time-equivalent employee
21 positions authorized for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation
22 in this act, eleven (11.0) shall perform duties in accordance with
23 the Criminal Intelligence Unit and nine (9.0) shall perform duties
24 in accordance with the Criminal Records Audit Unit. The

1 continuation of these full-time-equivalent employees is contingent
2 upon sufficient agency revolving funds to support them.

3 SECTION 6. The Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of
4 Investigation may request that the receipt and expenditure of
5 unanticipated federal funds after July 1, 2014, be exempt from
6 expenditure limitations, provided that any such funds are used for
7 operations and shall be included in the agency's budget work
8 program.

9 SECTION 7. Appropriations made by this act, not including
10 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
11 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 (hereafter FY-14) or may be
12 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 (hereafter FY-15).
13 Funds budgeted for FY-14 may be encumbered only through June 30,
14 2014, and must be expended by November 15, 2014. Any funds
15 remaining after November 15, 2014, and not budgeted for FY-15, shall
16 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
17 year. Funds budgeted for FY-15 may be encumbered only through June
18 30, 2015. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2015, shall lapse
19 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
20 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
21 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-14, and not required to pay
22 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-15, after
23 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
24 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds

1 from the FY-14 budget work program and after such revision has been
2 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

3 SECTION 8. This act shall become effective September 1, 2013.

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
