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9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
11 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control; making an
12 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting
13 in certain categories and amounts; providing for the
14 duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary
15 of the Director; providing budgetary limitations;
16 limiting amount of appropriation which may be used
17 for certain purpose; authorizing transfer of funds to
18 an agency special account for certain purposes;
19 limiting amount authorized to be transferred;
20 requiring promulgation of certain rules; providing
21 lapse dates; requiring and prohibiting certain budget
22 practices; and providing an effective date.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State
Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control from any monies not
otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the sum of
_____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be

1 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State
2 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control by law.

3 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the
4 Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control shall
5 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

14 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
15 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
16 upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs
17 Control by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the
18 Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum,
19 payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014. The
20 Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control for
21 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, shall be subject to the
22 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
23 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
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1 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
2 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

6 Full-time-equivalent employees solely paid by grant funds shall
7 not count against the agency's budgetary limitations as specified in
8 this section.

9 SECTION 4. Of the amount appropriated to the Oklahoma State
10 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control by Section 1 of this
11 act, an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
12 (\$200,000.00) may be transferred to an agency special account
13 established pursuant to the provisions of Section 34.56 of Title 62
14 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Funds in this account are to purchase
15 controlled dangerous substances to be used as evidence in narcotic
16 cases, for fees for informers, or employees, and for other expenses
17 necessary to apprehend and convict violators of state laws
18 regulating controlled dangerous substances. The Director of the
19 Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control and
20 the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services
21 shall promulgate rules for the expenditure of the funds transferred
22 by this section.

23 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act, not including
24 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for

1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 (hereafter FY-14) or may be
2 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 (hereafter FY-15).
3 Funds budgeted for FY-14 may be encumbered only through June 30,
4 2014, and must be expended by November 15, 2014. Any funds
5 remaining after November 15, 2014, and not budgeted for FY-15, shall
6 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
7 year. Funds budgeted for FY-15 may be encumbered only through June
8 30, 2015. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2015, shall lapse
9 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
10 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
11 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-14, and not required to pay
12 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-15, after
13 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
14 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
15 from the FY-14 budget work program and after such revision has been
16 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

17 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective September 1, 2013.

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
