9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to state government personnel;  
11 amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 3601.1, which relates  
12 to full-time-equivalent state employees; clarifying  
13 fiscal year, clarifying agency name; removing  
14 consolidated agencies; and providing an effective  
15 date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 3601.1, is  
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 3601.1 A. For purposes of Sections 3601.1 through 3603  
20 of this title, the term "employee" means a full-time employee or any  
21 number of part-time employees whose combined weekly hours of  
22 employment equal those of a full-time employee, but shall not  
23 include temporary employees working on a seasonal basis between May  
24 1 and October 31.

1 B. Beginning ~~July 1, 2008~~ October 1, 2013, the maximum number  
 2 of full-time-equivalent employees for each of the following  
 3 agencies, boards, commissions, departments, or programs shall not  
 4 exceed the numbers specified in this section, except as may be  
 5 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of this title.

13 C. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise  
14 prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the  
15 Oklahoma Public Employees Retirement System Board of Trustees by law  
16 shall be set by the Board of Trustees.

17 D. Temporary employees of the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and  
18 Parts Commission between the dates of November 1 and January 31  
19 annually shall not be counted toward the maximum number of full-  
20 time-equivalent employees provided for in this section.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective October 1, 2013.
