6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to courts; authorizing district court
8 judges to carry firearms under certain circumstances;
9 providing for codification; and providing an
10 effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 129 of Title 20, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A district judge may carry a firearm on his or her person
17 anywhere in the state to use only for personal protection if the
18 person has successfully completed an approved course of firearm
19 training conducted by a state-certified firearms instructor which
20 meets the minimum requirements for firearms training as set forth by
21 the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
