7 An Act relating to marriage; requiring person
8 receiving child support payments in certain cases to
9 show proof of how the money is spent; providing for
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 112.8 of Title 43, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Upon petition by the person obligated to pay child support, the
16 court shall order the person receiving child support payments to
17 report to the court as to how the child support payments are being
18 spent by furnishing receipts, bank statements or other records.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
