6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to criminal procedure; amending 22
8 O.S. 2011, Section 996.1, which relates to the
9 Delayed Sentencing Program for Young Adults;
10 modifying certain definition; and providing an
11 effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 22 O.S. 2011, Section 996.1, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 996.1 As used in the Delayed Sentencing Program for
16 Young Adults:

17 "Offender" means any adult eighteen (18) through twenty-one (21)
18 years of age as of the date of a verdict of guilty or a plea of
19 guilty or nolo contendere for a nonviolent felony offense or a
20 juvenile who has been certified to stand trial as an adult for a
21 nonviolent felony offense, ~~and~~ who has not been convicted of assault
22 and battery with a dangerous weapon, aggravated assault and battery
23 on a law officer, poisoning with intent to kill, shooting or
24 discharging a firearm with intent to kill, assault with intent to

1 kill, using a vehicle to facilitate the intentional discharge of any
2 kind of firearm in violation of Section 652 of Title 21 of the
3 Oklahoma Statutes, discharging any firearm or other deadly weapon at
4 or into any dwelling, assault with intent to commit a felony, murder
5 in the first degree, murder in the second degree, manslaughter in
6 the first degree, manslaughter in the second degree, kidnapping,
7 burglary in the first degree, kidnapping for extortion, maiming,
8 robbery, child beating, wiring any equipment, vehicle, or structure
9 with explosives, forcible sodomy, rape in the first degree or rape
10 by instrumentation, lewd or indecent proposition or lewd or indecent
11 act with a child under sixteen (16) years of age, use of a firearm
12 or offensive weapon to commit or attempt to commit a felony,
13 pointing firearms, rioting, arson in the first degree, ~~or~~ child
14 pornography, unlawful manufacturing, attempting to unlawfully
15 manufacture or aggravated manufacturing of any controlled dangerous
16 substance, or any violation of the Trafficking in Illegal Drugs Act,
17 and who has no charges pending for a violent offense.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
