6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to statutes and reports; amending 75  
8 O.S. 2011, Sections 13, 14 and 17, which relate to  
9 the Oklahoma Statutes and Oklahoma Session Laws;  
10 providing for the electronic transmission of statutes  
11 and session laws; authorizing the Chief Clerk of the  
12 House of Representatives to provide for the  
13 electronic transmission of statutes and session laws,  
14 unless printed volumes are requested; and providing  
15 an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 75 O.S. 2011, Section 13, is  
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 13. The Chief Clerk ~~Administrator~~ of the House of  
20 Representatives is authorized to purchase the required number of  
21 statutes and session laws for distribution pursuant to the  
22 provisions of Section 14 of this title and provide for the  
23 electronic transmission of statutes and session laws in lieu of  
24 distribution of printed volumes to persons provided for in Sections  
14 and 17 of this title, unless those persons request in writing  
that they receive printed volumes.

1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 75 O.S. 2011, Section 14, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 14. A. The following officers shall be entitled to  
4 receive as soon as available from the state without cost copies of  
5 the printed volumes of the statutes and session laws of the state  
6 published or purchased by the Legislature, or under its authority,  
7 for distribution; provided, however, unless an officer provided for  
8 in this subsection submits a written request for printed volumes to  
9 the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives, the Chief Clerk  
10 shall transmit the statutes and session laws to the officer in  
11 electronic form:

12 1. Each state officer, including the Governor and Lieutenant  
13 Governor, the chief administrative officers and assistants of state  
14 departments, boards, and commissions, upon written application and  
15 request submitted to the Chief Clerk-~~Administrator~~ of the Oklahoma  
16 House of Representatives, within sixty (60) days of January 1 of  
17 each year, and said volumes shall be distributed at the discretion  
18 of the Chief Clerk-~~Administrator~~ of the Oklahoma House of  
19 Representatives; ~~and~~

20 2. Each member of the Legislature; ~~and~~

21 3. The Justices of the Supreme Court and the Judges of the  
22 Court of Criminal Appeals, and the clerk of said Courts; ~~and~~

23 4. The chief administrative officers of the state educational,  
24 benevolent, and penal institutions; ~~and~~

- 1           5. The judges of the district courts and district court clerks;  
2 ~~and~~  
3           6. County clerks; ~~and~~  
4           7. County treasurers; ~~and~~  
5           8. County assessors; ~~and~~  
6           9. District attorneys and one assistant district attorney in  
7 each county; ~~and~~  
8           10. Sheriffs; ~~and~~  
9           11. All members of the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation; and  
10           12. Each library association organized in any county, city, or  
11 town in this state for the benefit of the public.

12           B. Fifty-five ~~(55)~~ copies of the statutes and session laws  
13 shall be furnished to the law library of the College of Law of the  
14 University of Oklahoma, five copies to be kept for use therein and  
15 fifty copies for purposes of exchange.

16           C. Five ~~(5)~~ copies of the statutes and session laws shall be  
17 placed in the library of Oklahoma State University at Stillwater,  
18 Oklahoma, for use therein.

19           D. One hundred ten ~~(110)~~ copies of the statutes and session  
20 laws shall be furnished to the Oklahoma Department of Libraries for  
21 its use and exchange purposes.

22           E. The Chief Clerk ~~Administrator may, in his~~ has the  
23 discretion, to furnish from any copies of such laws on hand to state  
24

1 officers other than those specified in this section for the use of  
2 their offices.

3 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 75 O.S. 2011, Section 17, is  
4 amended to read as follows:

5 Section 17. The county clerks of the several counties of this  
6 state, by the first Monday of February next succeeding the time when  
7 any regular session of the Legislature shall be held, shall make a  
8 requisition upon the Chief Clerk-~~Administrator~~ of the House of  
9 Representatives for as many copies of the laws of said session as  
10 may be required to supply one copy to each county or township  
11 officer entitled to the same pursuant to the provisions of Section  
12 14 of this title; provided, however, unless a county clerk submits a  
13 written request for printed volumes to the Chief Clerk, the Chief  
14 Clerk shall transmit the laws to the county clerk in electronic  
15 form. The Chief Clerk-~~Administrator~~ shall forward the number of  
16 copies of printed volumes called for by said requisition, to said  
17 clerk, either by express, or in any other secure manner. The county  
18 clerk, upon receiving the laws, shall distribute them to the several  
19 officers entitled by law to the same, obtaining a receipt describing  
20 the volumes and the date delivered, which shall be filed in the  
21 office of the county clerk.

22 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
