6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; authorizing
8 certain officials to replace certain appointments;
9 providing exceptions; providing for codification; and
10 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8.1 of Title 74, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 In addition to any appointments created by expiring terms or
17 vacancies provided by law, the Governor and any other executive
18 branch official with appointing authority shall have the power to
19 make a one-time replacement to each and every one of their office's
20 appointments to any board or commission. Appointees assuming office
21 under this provision shall be subject to Senate confirmation if
22 otherwise required by law for the position to which they are
23 appointed. Nothing in this section shall apply to any state agency.
24 Nothing in this section shall apply to appointments to any board or

1 commission if the appointment authority is provided for in the
2 Constitution.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 464.1 of Title 74, unless there
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 In addition to any appointments created by expiring terms or
7 vacancies provided by law, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate
8 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall have the power
9 to make a one-time replacement to each and every one of their
10 office's appointments to any board or commission. Appointees
11 assuming office under this provision shall be subject to Senate
12 confirmation if otherwise required by law for the position to which
13 they are appointed. Nothing in this section shall apply to any
14 state agency. Nothing in this section shall apply to appointments
15 to any board or commission if the appointment authority is provided
16 for in the Constitution.

17 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
