6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to oil and gas; requiring commercial
8 injection or disposal wells to be metered; requiring
9 operators of commercial injection or disposal wells
10 to maintain a log of certain substances disposed of
11 at the well; requiring log to be kept for certain
time period; specifying contents of the log;
12 requiring certain chain of custody evidence;
13 providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 155 of Title 52, unless there is
17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The Corporation Commission shall require commercial
19 injection or disposal wells to be metered so as to record the volume
20 of fluids disposed of in the well.

21 B. The Corporation Commission shall require the operator of a
22 commercial injection or disposal well to keep and make available
23 upon request of the Commission a log of all loads of deleterious
24 substances disposed at the well. The log shall be kept on file for

1 a period of at least five (5) years. The log of record shall
2 include, at a minimum, the amount, the location of the source, and
3 the operator or owner of the source of the deleterious substance.
4 The operator shall also require the hauler of the deleterious
5 substance to submit evidence of the chain of custody of the
6 deleterious substance. The chain of custody evidence shall be
7 included in the log of record.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.

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
