7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
8 prohibiting the performance and interpretation of
9 needle electromyography unless certain licenses are
held; providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 651 of Title 59, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 It shall be unlawful to perform and interpret needle
17 electromyography or interpret nerve conduction studies and evoked
18 potentials in this state unless such person has been duly licensed
19 as an allopathic physician or an osteopathic physician.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
