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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public finance; imposing duty on  
8 certain state government entities with respect to  
9 reduction of federal appropriations or federal block  
10 grant or other funds; requiring information to be  
11 provided to the Director of the Office of Management  
12 and Enterprise Services, the Governor, the Speaker of  
13 the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the  
14 President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate;  
15 imposing requirements for disclosure of federal funds  
16 and analysis regarding reliance and costs for  
17 compliance; providing for codification; and declaring  
18 an emergency.

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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.42.1 of Title 62, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Each agency subject to the provisions of the Office of State  
Finance Act shall develop a contingency plan and corresponding  
budget to be prepared for up to a twenty-five percent (25%)  
reduction in any applicable federal monies, whether appropriated or  
received in block grant or any other form.

1 B. The contingency plan and corresponding budget shall be  
2 submitted to the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
3 Services, the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of  
4 Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State  
5 Senate within thirty (30) days from the effective date of this act.

6 C. Every entity subject to the requirements of this section  
7 shall make an annual disclosure, either pursuant to a separate  
8 written report, information available through a website maintained  
9 by or on behalf of the entity or both, of all federal funds under  
10 the control of the entity and the programs for which the federal  
11 funds are used by distinct expenditure categories and shall identify  
12 the priority or rank of the federal funds in descending order with  
13 the funding source the agency relies on to the greatest extent  
14 listed first and the funding source the agencies relies on to the  
15 least extent listed last.

16 D. Every entity subject to the requirements of this section  
17 shall make an annual disclosure either pursuant to a separate  
18 written report, information available through a website maintained  
19 by or on behalf of the entity or both, of the federal funds for  
20 which the agency must incur costs to implement and shall provide  
21 such information in descending order with the most costly federal  
22 funds listed first and the least costly federal funds listed last.

23 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
24 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
