7 An Act relating to poor persons; providing for
8 copayment for SoonerCare services; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

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11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1012 of Title 56, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 All medical service providers under the state's SoonerCare
16 program shall collect a five-dollar copayment at the time services
17 are rendered. The state shall seek a waiver from the Centers for
18 Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) if necessary to implement this
19 policy. The copayment shall be retained by the service providers as
20 additional incentive to accommodate those seeking services. The
21 copayment may be waived in whole or in part entirely at the
22 discretion of the medical service provider.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
