6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to intoxicating liquors; prohibiting  
8 purchase of low-point beer using certain system;  
9 providing penalty; providing for codification; and  
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 163.30 of Title 37, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. This section applies to a licensee or permittee who is  
16 authorized to sell low-point beer to an ultimate consumer for  
17 consumption off the premises.

18 B. It is unlawful for any licensee or permittee to offer low-  
19 point beer for sale in any manner that allows the public to purchase  
20 the low-point beer using a computer-assisted checkout system. Low-  
21 point beer may only be purchased from the licensee or permittee or  
22 an employee of the licensee or permittee.

23 C. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall impose the following  
24 penalties for a violation of subsection B of this section:

1 1. After notice and hearing, immediately revoke the license or  
2 permit of the licensee or permittee committing the violation; and

3 2. Impose a fine of not more than One Thousand Dollars  
4 (\$1,000.00) for each violation.

5 Any licensee or permittee whose license or permit is revoked  
6 pursuant to this subsection shall not be eligible to reapply for a  
7 license for at least three (3) months from the date of the  
8 revocation. Any stock of low-point beer in the possession of such  
9 licensee or permittee shall be repurchased by the wholesaler.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
