6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to agriculture; stating legislative  
8 intent; providing for noncodification; and providing  
9 an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
13 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

14 It is the intent of the Legislature to support the control of  
15 invasive plants and animal species. It is the specific intent of  
16 the Legislature to support increased agricultural burning to control  
17 noxious weeds and eastern red cedar trees and to encourage county,  
18 state and federal government control of eastern red cedar trees on  
19 right-of-ways.

20 It is also the specific intent of the Legislature to diligently  
21 address the problem of feral hog eradication by increasing funding  
22 to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry. The  
23 Legislature encourages the Oklahoma Department of Corrections to  
24 pursue the processing of feral hogs for use by state correctional

1 facilities and any excess to be made available to any available  
2 markets, including food banks.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
