6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety; amending
8 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-2505.1, which relates to the
9 emergency medical technician and medical responder
10 death benefit; increasing amount of death benefit;
11 and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-2505.1, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 A. In the event of the death of an emergency medical technician
16 or a registered emergency medical responder resulting from the
17 official duties of such emergency medical technician or registered
18 emergency medical responder performed while in the line of duty, the
19 State Department of Health shall pay the designated beneficiary of
20 the technician or responder the sum of ~~Five Thousand Dollars~~
21 ~~(\$5,000.00)~~ Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).

22 B. If the designated beneficiary predeceases the emergency
23 medical technician or registered emergency medical responder and
24 there is not an alternate or contingent beneficiary, the death

1 benefit shall be payable to the personal representative of the
2 decedent.

3 C. All payments made pursuant to the provisions of this section
4 shall be paid from the Emergency Medical Personnel Death Benefit
5 Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 1-2505.2 of this title.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
