6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.  
8 2011, Section 840-5.12, which relates to employees of  
9 the State Department of Rehabilitation Services;  
10 modifying number of unclassified positions in the  
11 Disability Determination Division; and providing an  
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 840-5.12, is  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 840-5.12 A. The State Department of Rehabilitation  
17 Services shall be under the Merit System. Except as otherwise  
18 provided in this section, all offices, positions and personnel shall  
19 be classified and subject to the provisions of the Merit System of  
20 Personnel Administration and rules promulgated hereunder. This  
21 section shall supersede and repeal any and all executive orders  
22 issued pursuant to Section 840-1.1 et seq. of this title to place  
23 the agency or its predecessors under the Merit System.

1 B. In addition to offices, positions and personnel that are  
2 unclassified pursuant to Section 840-5.5 of this title, the Director  
3 of the State Department of Rehabilitation Services may establish  
4 positions in the unclassified service and place employees in the  
5 positions provided the total number of unclassified positions does  
6 not exceed fifty-two ~~(52)~~. This limit does not include State  
7 Department of Rehabilitation Services employees subject to Section  
8 840-5.3 of this title.

9 C. The limit on unclassified positions provided for in  
10 subsection B of this section shall not apply to the instructional  
11 and administrative personnel at the Oklahoma School for the Blind  
12 and the Oklahoma School for the Deaf as listed in Section 1419 of  
13 Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

14 D. The limit on unclassified positions provided for in  
15 subsection B of this section shall not apply to the employees of the  
16 Disability Determination Division of the State Department of  
17 Rehabilitation Services. The Director of the State Department of  
18 Rehabilitation Services may establish positions in the unclassified  
19 service in the Disability Determination Division and may place  
20 employees in those positions provided the total number of those  
21 unclassified positions does not exceed ~~fourteen~~ twenty-one.

22 E. Instructional and administrative personnel of the State  
23 Department of Rehabilitation Services at the Oklahoma School for the  
24 Blind and the Oklahoma School for the Deaf pursuant to Section 1419

1 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be considered  
2 unclassified state employees solely for the purpose of entering and  
3 maintaining employment data in the state Personnel Management  
4 Information System established pursuant to Section 840-2.13 of this  
5 title, unless otherwise provided by law.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
