6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to fees; authorizing certain entities
8 to recover a jail booking fee; providing for use of
9 fee; prohibiting court from waiving fee; providing
for collection and deposit of fee; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 153.4 of Title 28, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 In any criminal case in which a defendant is admitted into a
17 jail facility and is subsequently convicted for a violation of state
18 law, the sheriff or jail trust authority responsible for operating
19 the jail facility in the county in which the conviction was obtained
20 shall be authorized to recover a minimum jail booking fee of Fifty
21 Dollars (\$50.00). The jail booking fee shall be used to defer any
22 costs associated with processing the defendant into the jail
23 facility. The jail booking fee shall not be waived by the court.
24 The court clerk shall collect the fee amount and may retain five

1 percent (5%) of the monies to be deposited in the Court Clerk
2 Revolving Fund to cover administrative costs and shall remit the
3 remainder to the Sheriff's Service Fee Account of the sheriff or
4 general fund of the jail trust authority of the county in which the
5 conviction was obtained.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2013.
