6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
8 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1442, which relates to
9 burglary; providing gender-neutral language;
10 modifying scope of certain prohibited act; and
11 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1442, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1442. Any person who has been previously convicted of
16 the crime of burglary who has in his or her possession, custody or
17 concealed about his or her person, or transports or causes to be
18 transported, any combination of three ~~(3)~~ or more of the following
19 tools:

- 20 1. Sledge hammer, ~~pry~~;
- 21 2. Pry bar, ~~punches, chisel, bolt~~;
- 22 3. Punches;
- 23 4. Chisel;
- 24 5. Bolt cutters; or

1 6. Any two-way communication device capable of transmitting and
2 receiving a wireless voice transmission including, but not limited
3 to, portable handheld two-way radios,
4 with the intent to use or employ such tools, or allow the same to be
5 used or employed, in the commission of a crime, or knowing that the
6 tools are to be used in the commission of a crime, shall be guilty
7 of a felony.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
