6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; making certain  
8 acts unlawful; providing penalty; defining term;  
9 providing for codification; and providing an  
10 effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-1120 of Title 47, unless  
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. When approaching and passing a sanitation worker, a person  
16 driving a motor vehicle shall exercise due care by reducing the  
17 speed of the motor vehicle and by leaving a safe distance between  
18 the motor vehicle and the sanitation worker of not less than five  
19 (5) feet until the motor vehicle is safely past the sanitation  
20 worker.

21 B. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this  
22 section shall be punished as provided for in Section 17-101 of Title  
23 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 C. As used in this section, "sanitation worker" means an  
2 individual engaged in the collection and transport of solid waste  
3 and recyclables.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
