6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to counties and county officers;  
8 amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 165, which relates to  
9 travel allowance; increasing travel allowance for  
10 certain county officers; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 165, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 165. A. In lieu of reimbursement for traveling  
15 expenses within their county each county commissioner and sheriff  
16 may receive a monthly travel allowance of ~~Six Hundred Dollars~~  
17 ~~(\$600.00)~~ Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$950.00). In lieu of the  
18 reimbursement for traveling expenses authorized by law for each  
19 county officer, each county assessor may receive a monthly travel  
20 allowance of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and each county clerk,  
21 court clerk and county treasurer may receive a monthly travel  
22 allowance of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00). Each such county  
23 officer may be subject to the penalty provided by Section 166 of

1 this title for failure to attend the meetings specified in that  
2 section.

3 B. All newly elected county officials shall be reimbursed by  
4 their respective counties for any approved training provided before  
5 such official takes office. Such training expenses shall be  
6 reimbursed in January when such official takes office.

7 C. The provisions of this section and Sections 163 and 164 of  
8 this title shall not prevent the emergency use of a county-owned  
9 vehicle or county-owned equipment by a county officer when such  
10 county officer is acting on behalf of the county or when such use is  
11 related to county business. As used in this subsection, "emergency"  
12 means an unforeseen combination of circumstances or the resulting  
13 state that calls for immediate action.

14 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
15 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
