6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety; creating
8 the Medicaid Sustainability and Cost Containment Act;
9 requiring the State Board of Health to promulgate
10 certain rules; providing for codification; and
11 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1016.1 of Title 36, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Medicaid
17 Sustainability and Cost Containment Act".

18 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1016.2 of Title 36, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 The State Board of Health shall promulgate rules:

22 1. To implement provider rates reflecting a Medicaid-to-
23 Medicare fee index of 0.95;

1 2. To require prior authorization for all controlled
2 substances. An exception shall apply for Medicaid-eligible
3 individuals under the age of nineteen (19) years with an ICD-9
4 diagnosis code of 314.00-314.99 or their equivalent (attention
5 deficit disorders) and/or a diagnosis code of 299.00-299.99 or their
6 equivalent (autism spectrum disorders);

7 3. To require prior authorization for all nongeneric
8 pharmaceuticals for Medicaid-eligible individuals;

9 4. To decrease to five per month the number of prescriptions
10 allowed for Medicaid-eligible individuals over the age of eighteen
11 (18) years, except for those residing in long-term care facilities,
12 who shall be limited to eight prescriptions per month;

13 5. To limit reimbursements to six emergency room visits per
14 calendar year for Medicaid-eligible individuals; and

15 6. To implement a study to evaluate potential cost savings of a
16 competitive bidding process for durable medical equipment and
17 diabetic supplies.

18 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
