6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the state flag; directing that the  
8 state flag be folded in a certain manner; providing  
9 for codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 91.4 of Title 25, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. The state flag shall be folded as follows:

16 1. Straighten out the flag to full length and fold in half  
17 lengthwise once;

18 2. Fold the flag in half lengthwise once more;

19 3. Start a triangular or diagonal fold by bringing the folded  
20 edge to the open edge;

21 4. Turn the outer point inward, parallel with the open edge, to  
22 form a second triangle;

23 5. Continue the triangular or diagonal folding until the  
24 resulting fold produces a blue triangle; and

6. Secure all edges into the folds.

B. A folded state flag should be stored or displayed in a manner that prevents tearing or soiling of the flag.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
