7 An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending 68
8 O.S. 2011, Section 2355, as amended by Section 2,
9 Chapter 253, O.S.L. 2013 (68 O.S. Supp. 2013, Section
10 2355), which relates to income tax rate upon
11 individuals and business entities; modifying
12 provisions enacted pursuant to Enrolled House Bill
13 No. 2032 of the 1st Session of the 54th Oklahoma
14 Legislature; amending 68 O.S. 2011, Section 2355, as
15 last amended by Section 1 of this act, which relates
16 to income tax rates upon individuals and business
17 entities; modifying top marginal rate of income tax
18 upon individuals; repealing Section 3, Chapter 253,
19 O.S.L. 2013 (68 O.S. Supp. 2013, Section 2355.1E),
20 which relates to certain revenue estimates by the
21 State Board of Equalization; and providing an
22 effective date.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2011, Section 2355, as
amended by Section 2, Chapter 253, O.S.L. 2013 (68 O.S. Supp. 2013,
Section 2355), is amended to read as follows:

Section 2355. A. Individuals. For all taxable years beginning
after December 31, 1998~~7~~ and before January 1, 2006, a tax is hereby
imposed upon the Oklahoma taxable income of every resident or

1 nonresident individual, which tax shall be computed at the option of
2 the taxpayer under one of the two following methods:

3 1. METHOD 1.

4 a. Single individuals and married individuals filing
5 separately not deducting federal income tax:

6 (1) 1/2% tax on first \$1,000.00 or part thereof,

7 (2) 1% tax on next \$1,500.00 or part thereof,

8 (3) 2% tax on next \$1,250.00 or part thereof,

9 (4) 3% tax on next \$1,150.00 or part thereof,

10 (5) 4% tax on next \$1,300.00 or part thereof,

11 (6) 5% tax on next \$1,500.00 or part thereof,

12 (7) 6% tax on next \$2,300.00 or part thereof, and

13 (8) (a) for taxable years beginning after December

14 31, 1998, and before January 1, 2002, 6.75%

15 tax on the remainder,

16 (b) for taxable years beginning on or after

17 January 1, 2002, and before January 1, 2004,

18 7% tax on the remainder, and

19 (c) for taxable years beginning on or after

20 January 1, 2004, 6.65% tax on the remainder.

3 is hereby imposed upon the Oklahoma taxable income of every resident
4 or nonresident individual, which tax shall be computed as follows:

8 (b) 1% tax on next \$1,500.00 or part thereof,

9 (c) 2% tax on next \$1,250.00 or part thereof,

19 December 31, 1989, a tax is hereby imposed upon the Oklahoma taxable
20 income of every corporation doing business within this state or
21 deriving income from sources within this state in an amount equal to
22 six percent (6%) thereof.

23 There shall be no additional Oklahoma income tax imposed on
24 accumulated taxable income or on undistributed personal holding

1 company income as those terms are defined in the Internal Revenue
2 Code.

3 ~~F.~~ E. Certain foreign corporations. In lieu of the tax imposed
4 in the first paragraph of subsection ~~D~~ C of this section, for all
5 taxable years beginning after December 31, 1989, there shall be
6 imposed on foreign corporations, as defined in the Internal Revenue
7 Code, a tax of six percent (6%) instead of thirty percent (30%) as
8 used in the Internal Revenue Code, where such income is received
9 from sources within Oklahoma, in accordance with the provisions of
10 the Internal Revenue Code and the Oklahoma Income Tax Act.

11 Every payer of amounts covered by this subsection shall deduct
12 and withhold from such amounts paid each payee an amount equal to
13 six percent (6%) thereof. Every payer required to deduct and
14 withhold taxes under this subsection shall for each quarterly period

6 ~~G.~~ F. Fiduciaries. A tax is hereby imposed upon the Oklahoma
7 taxable income of every trust and estate at the same rates as are
8 provided in subsection B ~~or C~~ of this section for single
9 individuals. Fiduciaries are not allowed a deduction for any
10 federal income tax paid.

11 ~~H.~~ G. Tax rate tables. For all taxable years beginning after
12 December 31, 1991, in lieu of the tax imposed by subsection A, or B
13 ~~or C~~ of this section, as applicable there is hereby imposed for each
14 taxable year on the taxable income of every individual, whose
15 taxable income for such taxable year does not exceed the ceiling
16 amount, a tax determined under tables, applicable to such taxable
17 year which shall be prescribed by the Tax Commission and which shall
18 be in such form as it determines appropriate. In the table so
19 prescribed, the amounts of the tax shall be computed on the basis of

7 the Tax Commission, and shall file a return with each such payment.
8 Such return shall be in such form as the Tax Commission shall
9 prescribe. Every payer required under this subsection to deduct and
10 withhold a tax from a payee shall, as to the total amounts paid to
11 each payee during the calendar year, furnish to such payee, on or
12 before January 31, of the succeeding year, a written statement
13 showing the name of the payer, the name of the payee and the payee's
14 social security account number, if any, the total amounts paid
15 subject to taxation, the total amount deducted and withheld as tax
16 and such other information as the Tax Commission may require. Any
17 payer who fails to withhold or pay to the Tax Commission any sums
18 herein required to be withheld or paid shall be personally and
19 individually liable therefor to the State of Oklahoma.

20 F. Fiduciaries. A tax is hereby imposed upon the Oklahoma
21 taxable income of every trust and estate at the same rates as are
22 provided in subsection B of this section for single individuals.
23 Fiduciaries are not allowed a deduction for any federal income tax
24 paid.

1 G. Tax rate tables. For all taxable years beginning after
2 December 31, 1991, in lieu of the tax imposed by subsection A or B
3 of this section, as applicable there is hereby imposed for each
4 taxable year on the taxable income of every individual, whose
5 taxable income for such taxable year does not exceed the ceiling
6 amount, a tax determined under tables, applicable to such taxable
7 year which shall be prescribed by the Tax Commission and which shall
8 be in such form as it determines appropriate. In the table so
9 prescribed, the amounts of the tax shall be computed on the basis of
10 the rates prescribed by subsections A and B of this section. For
11 purposes of this subsection, the term "ceiling amount" means, with
12 respect to any taxpayer, the amount determined by the Tax Commission
13 for the tax rate category in which such taxpayer falls.

14 SECTION 3. REPEALER Section 3, Chapter 253, O.S.L. 2013
15 (68 O.S. Supp. 2013, Section 2355.1E), is hereby repealed.

16 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective January 1, 2016.
