7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
8 21 O.S. 2011, Section 733, which relates to
9 justifiable homicide; clarifying certain provision;
and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 733, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 733. Homicide is also justifiable when committed by any
16 person in either of the following cases:

17 1. When resisting any attempt to murder such person, or to
18 commit any felony upon him, or upon or in any dwelling house in
19 which such person is; or,

20 2. When committed in the lawful defense of such person, or of
21 ~~his or her husband, wife, parent, child, master, mistress, or~~
22 ~~servant~~ another, when there is a reasonable ~~ground to apprehend a~~
23 ~~design to commit~~ belief that such force is necessary to prevent the
24 imminent commission of a forcible felony, or to do some to prevent

1 imminent death or great personal injury, ~~and imminent danger of such~~
2 ~~design being accomplished~~ to himself or herself or to another; or,

3 3. When necessarily committed in attempting, by lawful ways and
4 means, to apprehend any person for any felony committed; or in
5 lawfully suppressing any riot; or in lawfully keeping and preserving
6 the peace.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
