6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to prisons and reformatories;
8 amending 57 O.S. 2011, Section 582, which relates to
9 the Sex Offenders Registration Act; making persons
10 convicted of certain crime subject to registration
11 requirements; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2011, Section 582, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 582. A. The provisions of the Sex Offenders
16 Registration Act shall apply to any person residing, working or
17 attending school within the State of Oklahoma who, after November 1,
18 1989, has been convicted, whether upon a verdict or plea of guilty
19 or upon a plea of nolo contendere, or received a suspended sentence
20 or any probationary term, or is currently serving a sentence or any
21 form of probation or parole for a crime or an attempt to commit a
22 crime provided for in Section 843.5 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
23 Statutes, if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual
24 exploitation as those terms are defined in Section 1-1-105 of Title

1 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes~~;~~ Section 681 of Title 21 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes, if the offense involved sexual assault~~;~~ Section
3 741 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, if the offense involved
4 sexual abuse or sexual exploitation~~;~~ Section 748 of Title 21 of the
5 Oklahoma Statutes, if the offense involved the trafficking of a
6 minor for commercial sex; Section 843.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
7 Statutes, if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual
8 exploitation~~;~~ Section 852.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
9 if the offense involved sexual abuse of a child~~;~~ Sections 865 et
10 seq., 885, 886, 888~~;~~ and 891 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
11 if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation~~;~~ and
12 Sections 1021, 1021.2, 1021.3, 1024.2, 1040.12a, 1040.13, 1040.13a,
13 1087, 1088, 1111.1, 1114 ~~or~~ and 1123 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
14 Statutes.

15 B. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall
16 apply to any person who after November 1, 1989, resides, works or
17 attends school within the State of Oklahoma and who has been
18 convicted or received a suspended sentence at any time in any court
19 of another state, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam,
20 American Samoa, the Northern Mariana Islands and the United States
21 Virgin Islands, a federal court, an Indian tribal court, a military
22 court, or a court of a foreign country for a crime, attempted crime
23 or a conspiracy to commit a crime which, if committed or attempted
24 in this state, would be a crime, an attempt to commit a crime or a

1 conspiracy to commit a crime provided for in any of said laws listed
2 in subsection A of this section.

3 C. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall
4 apply to any person who resides, works or attends school within the
5 State of Oklahoma and who has received a deferred judgment at any
6 time in any court of another state, the District of Columbia, Puerto
7 Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the Northern Mariana Islands and the
8 United States Virgin Islands, a federal court, an Indian tribal
9 court, a military court, or a court of a foreign country for a
10 crime, attempted crime or a conspiracy to commit a crime which, if
11 committed or attempted or conspired to be committed in this state,
12 would be a crime, an attempt to commit a crime or a conspiracy to
13 commit a crime provided for in Section 843.5 of Title 21 of the
14 Oklahoma Statutes, if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual
15 exploitation as those terms are defined in Section 1-1-105 of Title
16 10A of the Oklahoma Statutes; Section 681 of Title 21 of the
17 Oklahoma Statutes, if the offense involved sexual assault; Section
18 741 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, if the offense involved
19 sexual abuse or sexual exploitation; Section 748 of Title 21 of the
20 Oklahoma Statutes, if the offense involved the trafficking of a
21 minor for commercial sex; Section 843.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
22 Statutes, if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual
23 exploitation; Section 852.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
24 if the offense involved sexual abuse of a child; Sections 865 et

1 seq., 885, 886, 888~~7~~ and 891 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
2 if the offense involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation~~7~~; and
3 Sections 1021, 1021.2, 1021.3, 1024.2, 1040.12a, 1040.13, 1040.13a,
4 1087, 1088, 1111.1, 1114 ~~or~~ and 1123 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
5 Statutes. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act
6 shall not apply to any such person while the person is incarcerated
7 in a maximum or medium correctional institution of the Department of
8 Corrections.

9 D. On the effective date of this act, any person registered as
10 a sex offender pursuant to Section 741 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
11 Statutes shall be summarily removed from the Sex Offender Registry
12 by the Department of Corrections and all law enforcement agencies of
13 any political subdivision of this state, unless the offense involved
14 sexual abuse or sexual exploitation.

15 E. The provisions of the Sex Offenders Registration Act shall
16 not apply to any such person who has received a criminal history
17 records expungement for a conviction in another state for a crime or
18 attempted crime which, if committed or attempted in this state,
19 would be a crime or an attempt to commit a crime provided for in any
20 said laws listed in subsection A of this section.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.

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
