7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to state government; making certain
9 reports and assessments of the Oklahoma Information
10 Fusion Center confidential; authorizing disclosure to
11 certain persons; making collected information
12 privileged and not discoverable; providing an
13 exception; providing for codification; and providing
14 an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 150.21c of Title 74, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. The information reports and intelligence assessments of the
20 Oklahoma Information Fusion Center shall be confidential and shall
21 not be open to the public; provided, however, members of the
22 Oklahoma Information Fusion Center may disclose, at the discretion
23 of the Oklahoma Information Fusion Center Director, such Fusion
24 Center information reports and intelligence assessments to:

1 1. Officers and agents of federal, state, county, or municipal
2 law enforcement agencies and appropriate prosecutorial authorities
3 for criminal investigation, criminal prosecution, crime prevention,
4 public safety, and Homeland Security purposes; and

5 2. Critical infrastructure and key resources personnel in the
6 private sector and other necessary private sector security officials
7 authorized by the Oklahoma Information Fusion Center Director to
8 receive such reports for public safety and Homeland Security
9 purposes.

10 B. Information collected and compiled under the authority of
11 this section shall be privileged and not discoverable, nor subject
12 to subpoena or order for production issued by any court, other than
13 production in a district court criminal proceeding for the
14 prosecution of crimes which are the subject of the information
15 sought.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
