12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
14 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

15 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Intangible  
16 Personal Property Exemption Revenue Analysis Act of 2014".

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
