6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to technology; establishing the
8 Oklahoma State Privacy Protection and Transparency
9 Initiative; directing the Chief Information Office to
10 develop and maintain a public access web-based data
11 object catalog; requiring certain definitions when
12 possible; requiring the sharing of data objects to be
13 itemized and detailed in the catalog; providing for
14 codification; providing an effective date; and
15 declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.11.11 of Title 62, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. There is hereby established the Oklahoma State Privacy
21 Protection and Transparency Initiative.

22 B. The Chief Information Officer shall develop and maintain a
23 publicly accessible web-based catalog listing each data object
24 collected by state government entities.

C. When possible, data objects shall be accompanied by a
definition allowing the reader to understand the purpose of the

1 object and providing a description of the data which is in each
2 object.

3 D. The catalog created in accordance with subsection B of this
4 section shall specifically itemize and detail the interagency and
5 intergovernmental sharing of data objects between state government
6 entities and between state government entities and non-state-
7 government entities.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

9 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
