6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Employment Security  
8 Commission; making appropriations; stating purposes;  
9 providing for expenditure limitations; and providing  
10 an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Employment  
13 Security Administration Fund, out of funds made available to this  
14 state by the federal Reed Act distribution made on October 1, 1998,  
15 pursuant to Section 903(d) of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C.,  
16 Section 1103(d), as amended, the sum of One Hundred Sixty-four  
17 Thousand One Hundred Thirty Dollars and thirty-six cents  
18 (\$164,130.36) to be used by the Oklahoma Employment Security  
19 Commission for the purpose of paying the administrative expenses of  
20 the Employment Service Program.

21 The funds appropriated by this section shall be expended before  
22 December 31, 2015. Expenditures from this appropriation shall be  
23 accounted for in accordance with standards established by the United  
24 States Secretary of Labor. The Oklahoma Employment Security

1 Commission shall utilize the appropriation made by this section in  
2 accordance with the provisions and requirements contained in the  
3 Social Security Act, Title 42 of the United States Code.

4 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Employment  
5 Security Administration Fund, out of funds made available to this  
6 state by the federal Reed Act distribution made on March 13, 2002,  
7 pursuant to Section 903(d) of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C.,  
8 Section 1103(d), as amended, the sum of Eleven Million Two Hundred  
9 Thirty-six Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-five Dollars and seventy-  
10 six cents (\$11,236,775.76) to be used by the Oklahoma Employment  
11 Security Commission for the purpose of paying the administrative  
12 expenses of the following programs in the following amounts:

13 1. Employer Service Program in the amount of Six Million Three  
14 Hundred Thirty-five Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-nine Dollars and  
15 sixty-four cents (\$6,335,869.64); and

16 2. Unemployment Insurance Program in the amount of Four Million  
17 Nine Hundred Thousand Nine Hundred Six Dollars and twelve cents  
18 (\$4,900,906.12).

19 The funds appropriated by this section shall be expended before  
20 December 15, 2015. Expenditures from this appropriation shall be  
21 accounted for in accordance with standards established by the United  
22 States Secretary of Labor. The Oklahoma Employment Security  
23 Commission shall utilize the appropriation made by this section in

1 accordance with the provisions and requirements contained in the  
2 Social Security Act, Title 42 of the United States Code.

3 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Employment  
4 Security Administration Fund, out of funds made available to this  
5 state by the federal Unemployment Compensation Modernization  
6 Transfer made on June 25, 2009, pursuant to Section 903(f) of the  
7 Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C., Section 1103(f), as amended, the sum  
8 of Five Hundred Ninety-nine Thousand Ninety-three Dollars and  
9 eighty-eight cents (\$599,093.88) to be used by the Oklahoma  
10 Employment Security Commission for the purpose of paying the  
11 administrative expenses of the Unemployment Insurance Program.

12 The funds appropriated by this section shall be expended before  
13 December 15, 2015. Expenditures from this appropriation shall be  
14 accounted for in accordance with standards established by the United  
15 States Secretary of Labor. The Oklahoma Employment Security  
16 Commission shall utilize the appropriation made by this section in  
17 accordance with the provisions and requirements contained in the  
18 Social Security Act, Title 42 of the United States Code.

19 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
