6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to alternative fuels; amending 74
8 O.S. 2011, Section 130.20, which relates to the
9 Alternative Fuels Technician Certification Act;
10 allowing a person certified as a technician to work
11 on certain vehicles and equipment; and declaring an
12 emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 130.20, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 130.20 After September 1, 1991, it shall be unlawful
17 for any person to perform the work or offer, by advertisement or
18 otherwise, to perform the work of an alternative fuels equipment
19 technician until such person has qualified and is certified as an
20 alternative fuels equipment technician. Beginning September 1,
21 1995, it shall be unlawful for any person to perform work or offer,
22 by advertisement or otherwise, to perform the work of an alternative
23 fuels compression technician until such person has qualified and is
24 certified as an alternative fuels compression technician. Beginning
November 1, 1998, it shall be unlawful for any person to perform the

1 work or offer, by advertisement or otherwise, to perform the work of
2 an electric vehicle technician until such person has qualified and
3 is certified as an electric vehicle technician. Electric vehicles
4 that have a manufacturer's warranty shall be serviced by an
5 authorized new car dealer. Any vehicle manufacturer's training
6 center located in the state, which offers alternative fuel and
7 electric vehicle courses meeting new car manufacturing requirements,
8 shall be exempted from this act. Provided, nothing in the
9 Alternative Fuels Technician Certification Act shall be construed to
10 prohibit a noncertified person from converting the engine of a farm
11 tractor, as defined in Section 1-118 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
12 Statutes, to an engine fueled by alternative fuels, as long as such
13 farm tractor is not operated on the roads and highways of this
14 state. Nothing in the Alternative Fuels Technician Certification
15 Act shall be construed to prohibit a person certified as an
16 alternative fuels equipment technician, alternative fuels
17 compression technician or electric vehicle technician from
18 performing work on a vehicle or equipment owned by the person.

19 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
