6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety;
8 requiring home care agency to adopt certain policy;
9 requiring certain applicants to undergo drug testing;
10 requiring certain employees to undergo drug testing
11 at certain time; providing for codification; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1971A of Title 63, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. Each home care agency, as defined in Section 1-1961 of Title
18 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be required to adopt a written
19 drug-testing policy as set forth in Section 555 of Title 40 of the
20 Oklahoma Statutes.

21 B. Any person who seeks employment as a home health aide, as
22 defined in Section 1-1961 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
23 shall be required to undergo drug testing as a condition of
24 employment, in accordance with the Standards for Workplace Drug and

1 Alcohol Testing Act, Sections 551 through 563 of Title 40 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes.

3 C. Any person who has been employed as a home health aide for
4 eighteen (18) months shall be required to undergo drug testing as a
5 condition of continued employment, in accordance with the Standards
6 for Workplace Drug and Alcohol Testing Act.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
