6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; establishing requirements
8 for graduation from certain high schools; repealing
9 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1210.523, as last amended by
10 Section 2, Chapter 403, O.S.L. 2013 (70 O.S. Supp.
11 2013, Section 1210.523), which relates to requirement
12 for mastery of state academic content standards in
13 designated subjects; providing for codification;
14 providing an effective date; and declaring an
15 emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-112 of Title 70, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 In order to graduate with a standard diploma from a public high
21 school accredited by the State Board of Education students shall:

22 1. Complete the curriculum requirements as provided for in
23 Section 11-103.6 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

24 2. Complete the testing requirements as provided for in Section
1210.508 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 3. Comply with the attendance requirements established by the
2 school district in which the student is enrolled; and

3 4. Comply with any other graduation requirement as established
4 by law or by the school district.

5 SECTION 2. REPEALER 70 O.S. 2011, Section 1210.523, as
6 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 403, O.S.L. 2013 (70 O.S. Supp.
7 2013, Section 1210.523), is hereby repealed.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

9 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
