6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to game and fish; amending 29 O.S.
8 2011, Section 4-138, which relates to wildlife
9 conservation passports; authorizing the Wildlife
10 Conservation Commission to establish certain
11 passports; authorizing the Commission to assess
12 certain fees; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2011, Section 4-138, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 4-138. A. The Wildlife Conservation Commission may
17 establish a special use ~~permit~~ permits to be designated the
18 "wildlife:

19 1. "Annual Wildlife Conservation Passport";

20 2. "Three-Day Wildlife Conservation Passport"; and

21 3. "One-Day Wildlife Conservation Passport".

22 ~~The~~ A Passport shall be required of all persons not otherwise
23 exempt as provided for in subsection C of this section, who enter or
24 use land owned by the Commission and that has been designated by the
Commission as requiring a Passport.

1 B. The Commission may establish and assess ~~an~~:

2 1. An annual fee of not more than One Dollar (\$1.00) above the
3 cost of an annual resident hunting or fishing license for the Annual
4 Wildlife Conservation Passport;

5 2. A one-time fee of not more than Seven Dollars (\$7.00) for
6 the Three-Day Wildlife Conservation Passport; and

7 3. A one-time fee of not more than Five Dollars (\$5.00) for the
8 One-Day Wildlife Conservation Passport.

9 Each person, not otherwise exempt as provided for in subsection
10 C of this section, entering or using a designated area of land shall
11 be required to have a Passport in their possession while in the
12 area.

13 C. The following persons shall be exempt from the Passport
14 requirements of this section:

15 1. All persons who possess a valid Oklahoma annual or
16 combination resident fishing or hunting license, an annual
17 nonresident fishing or hunting license, a lifetime resident or
18 nonresident fishing, hunting, or combination license, a senior
19 citizen lifetime fishing or hunting license, or a disability fishing
20 or hunting license;

21 2. Legal residents of Oklahoma who are under eighteen (18)
22 years of age on the first day of the current calendar year; and

23 3. Students and instructors participating in bona fide
24 educational tours or activities sponsored or organized by an

1 educational institution or entity or any other organized event
2 sanctioned in advance by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife
3 Conservation. Sponsors of such activities shall provide notice of
4 the date and number of persons participating in the activity to the
5 Department of Wildlife Conservation for approval not less than
6 twenty (20) days prior to the date of the activity.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
