6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety; amending
8 63 O.S. 2011, Section 2-103a, which relates to annual
9 salaries of certain Oklahoma State Bureau of
10 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control personnel;
11 modifying salaries; providing an effective date; and
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 2-103a, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 2-103a. A. Effective ~~January 1, 2007~~ July 1, 2014, the
17 annual salaries for positions within the Oklahoma State Bureau of
18 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control specified in this section
19 shall be in accordance and conformity with the following salary
20 schedule, exclusive of longevity pay as authorized by Section 840-
21 2.18 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

- 22 1. Director: ~~\$96,305.00~~ \$122,310.00;
23 2. Deputy Director:

1 The salary of the Deputy Director shall be
2 ninety-five percent (95%) of that received
3 by the Director;

4 3. Division Director:

5 The salary of the Division Director shall
6 be ninety percent (90%) of that received
7 by the Director;

8 4. Level I Agent (OBNDD):

9 Minimum ~~\$35,287.00~~ \$44,825.00, Mid-point
10 ~~\$41,875.00~~ \$53,185.00,
11 Maximum ~~\$50,250.00~~ \$63,820.00;

12 5. Level II Agent (OBNDD):

13 Minimum ~~\$43,714.00~~ \$55,525.00, Mid-point
14 ~~\$49,062.00~~ \$62,310.00,
15 Maximum ~~\$58,875.00~~ \$74,775.00;

16 6. Level III Agent (OBNDD):

17 Minimum ~~\$50,042.00~~ \$63,560.00, Mid-point
18 ~~\$57,812.00~~ \$73,425.00,
19 Maximum ~~\$69,375.00~~ \$88,110.00;

20 7. Level IV Agent (OBNDD):

21 Minimum ~~\$58,365.00~~ \$74,125.00, Mid-point
22 ~~\$63,750.00~~ \$80,965.00,
23 Maximum ~~\$76,500.00~~ \$97,155.00; and

24 8. Level V Agent (OBNDD):

1 Minimum ~~\$66,140.00~~ \$84,000.00; Mid-point
2 ~~\$70,000.00~~ \$88,900.00,
3 Maximum ~~\$84,000.00~~ \$106,680.00.

4 Provided, however, no employee in any such position shall
5 receive less than the salary the employee received on December 31,
6 ~~2006~~ 2013.

7 B. Effective ~~January 1, 2007~~ July 1, 2014, all positions may
8 receive additional compensation through the use of pay mechanisms
9 provided for in the Oklahoma Personnel Act and the Merit System of
10 Personnel Administration Rules.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.

12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
