6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to counties and county officers;  
8 authorizing county commissioners to carry firearms  
9 under certain circumstances; providing for  
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 339.9 of Title 19, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Upon completion of an approved course of firearm training  
16 conducted by a certified firearms instructor which is equal to the  
17 minimum requirements for firearms training as set forth by the  
18 Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training, a county  
19 commissioner may carry a firearm on his or her person anywhere  
20 within the district of the county commissioner for personal  
21 protection only and when acting in the course of employment.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
