7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending  
8 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1192, which relates to the  
9 spread of infectious diseases; expanding scope of  
certain prohibited act; and providing an effective  
date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1192, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1192. Any person who ~~shall inoculate himself or any~~  
15 ~~other person or shall suffer~~ knows himself or herself to be  
16 ~~inoculated~~ infected with smallpox, syphilis ~~or~~, gonorrhoea, Hepatitis  
17 C, human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) or genital human papilloma  
18 virus (HPV) and shall spread or cause to be spread to any other  
19 persons with intent to or recklessly be responsible for the spread  
20 of or prevalence of such infectious disease, ~~shall be deemed a~~  
21 ~~felon, and, upon conviction thereof,~~ be guilty of a felony and shall  
22 be punished by imprisonment in the ~~State Penitentiary~~ custody of the  
23 Department of Corrections for not more than five (5) years nor less  
24 than two (2) years.
