6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to statutes and reports; authorizing
8 statement in legislative measures related to Section
9 57 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution;
10 providing for presumption based upon approval of
statement; prescribing required vote for approval;
providing for codification; and declaring an
emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10 of Title 75, unless there is
16 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 An act of the Legislature which:

18 1. Amends two or more sections of law in the same title of the
19 Oklahoma Statutes;

20 2. Contains both amendatory and new law provisions in the same
21 title of the Oklahoma Statutes;

22 3. Contains a combination of amendatory and new law provisions
23 in more than one title of the Oklahoma Statutes;

1 4. Contains two or more sections of new law in different titles
2 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
3 5. Contains two or more repealers in different titles of the
4 Oklahoma Statutes; or
5 6. Otherwise contains combinations of amendatory provisions,
6 new law provisions, repealers, recodifications or other
7 modifications to the Oklahoma Statutes,
8 shall be presumed to contain only one subject within the meaning of
9 Section 57 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution if the
10 Legislature includes a statement or explanation of the logical
11 connection between and among the applicable provisions and the
12 statement or explanation, which shall be a separate section from the
13 other provisions of the measure, receives simple majority
14 affirmative approval of both chambers of the Legislature upon final
15 passage of such measure.

16 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
