6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to compensation of public officials;
8 amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 250.4, which relates
9 to salary amounts; prescribing salary amounts for
10 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General,
11 State Superintendent of Public Instruction, members
12 of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission, State
13 Treasurer; State Auditor and Inspector, Insurance
14 Commissioner and the Commissioner of Labor; removing
15 provisions related to compensation of justices and
16 judges; and declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 250.4, is
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 250.4 Pursuant to provisions of the Constitution of the
21 State of Oklahoma from and after the beginning date of a term of
22 office which commences in, or after, January, 1999, the following
23 officers of the State of Oklahoma shall be annually compensated for
24 their services, payable monthly, as follows:

1. The Governor shall receive a salary ~~equal to the salary~~
~~received by the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court~~ of One
Hundred Forty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$147,000.00);

1 2. The Lieutenant Governor shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~
2 ~~salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a~~
3 ~~population greater than ten thousand (10,000) and less than thirty~~
4 ~~thousand (30,000) of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred~~
5 Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);

6 3. The Attorney General shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~
7 ~~salary received by the Presiding Judge of the Court of Civil Appeals~~
8 ~~of One Hundred Thirty Two Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-five Dollars~~
9 (\$132,825.00);

10 4. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall receive
11 a salary ~~equal to the salary received by a district judge of One~~
12 ~~Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-three Dollars~~
13 (\$124,373.00);

14 5. Each member of the Corporation Commission shall receive a
15 salary ~~equal to the salary received by an associate district judge~~
16 ~~in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000) of~~
17 ~~One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars~~
18 (\$114,713.00);

19 6. The State Treasurer shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~
20 ~~salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a~~
21 ~~population of over thirty thousand (30,000) of One Hundred Fourteen~~
22 ~~Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);~~

23 7. The State Auditor and Inspector shall receive a salary ~~equal~~
24 ~~to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county~~

1 ~~with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000) of One Hundred~~
2 ~~Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);~~

3 8. The State Insurance Commissioner shall receive a salary
4 ~~equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a~~
5 ~~county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000) of One~~
6 ~~Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars~~
7 ~~(\$114,713.00); and~~

8 9. The Commissioner of Labor shall receive a salary ~~equal to~~
9 ~~the salary received by a special judge of One Hundred Five Thousand~~
10 ~~Fifty-three Dollars (\$105,053.00).~~

11 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
