6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
8 2011, Sections 7-212 and 7-217, which relate to
9 security following an accident; extending the
10 duration of suspension of driving privilege;
11 modifying conditions in which security may be used
12 for payment of certain judgment; and proving an
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 7-212, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 7-212. Unless a suspension is terminated under other
18 provisions of this chapter, any order of suspension by the
19 Department of Public Safety under this chapter shall remain in
20 effect and no license shall be renewed for or issued to any person
21 whose driving privilege is suspended until:

22 1. The person shall deposit and file or there shall be
23 deposited and filed on behalf of the person the security and proof
24 of financial responsibility required under this chapter~~7~~i or

1 2. ~~One (1) year~~ Two (2) years shall have elapsed following the
2 date of the suspension and evidence satisfactory to the Department
3 has been filed with it that during the ~~one-year~~ two-year period no
4 action for damages arising out of the accident resulting in the
5 suspension has been instituted, provided, the person has filed the
6 required proof of financial responsibility.

7 An affidavit of the applicant that no action at law for damages
8 arising out of the accident has been filed against him or her or, if
9 filed, that it is not still pending shall be prima facie evidence of
10 that fact. The Department may take whatever steps are necessary to
11 verify the statement set forth in the affidavit.

12 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 7-217, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 7-217. Such security shall be applicable and available
15 only:

16 1. For the payment of any settlement agreement covering any
17 claim arising out of the accident upon instruction of the person who
18 made the deposit, ~~or~~ or

19 2. For the payment of a judgment or judgments, rendered against
20 the person required to make the deposit, for damages arising out of
21 the accident in an action at law begun not later than ~~one (1) year~~
22 two (2) years after the deposit of such security, or within ~~one (1)~~
23 ~~year~~ two (2) years after the date of deposit of any security
24 following failure to make payments under an agreement to pay.

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SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
