6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to soldiers and sailors; amending 72  
8 O.S. 2011, Section 7, which relates to free admission  
9 to state parks and museums; providing that certain  
10 identification will be sufficient evidence for free  
11 admission; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 72 O.S. 2011, Section 7, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 7. A. All honorably discharged veterans who are  
16 currently Oklahoma residents shall be allowed free admission to all  
17 state-owned or state-operated parks and museums. A valid Oklahoma  
18 driver license or state photo identification card and military  
19 discharge papers (DD Form 214) or similar evidence of an honorable  
20 discharge from the United States Armed Forces shall be required for  
21 free admission.

22 B. A valid Oklahoma driver license or identification card  
23 issued by the Department of Public Safety with a flag emblem and the  
24 word "veteran" in the upper left-hand corner of the front of the

1 driver license or identification card shall be sufficient evidence  
2 of an honorable discharge for purposes of subsection A of this  
3 section.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
