6 AS INTRODUCE

7 An Act relating to schools; prohibiting a technology  
8 center school district from offering FFA chapters,  
9 affiliated courses or certain agriculture education  
10 courses if offered at a public school under certain  
11 conditions; listing conditions; prohibiting a  
12 technology center school district from participating  
13 in certain courses or contests certified by an FFA  
14 organization; providing for codification; and  
15 declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-108.2 of Title 70, unless  
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. A technology center school district shall not offer any FFA  
21 chapters or any FFA affiliated course, courses or contests, any  
22 agricultural education course, including, but not limited to,  
23 agricultural exploration and orientation, agriscience, horticulture,  
24 agronomy, soil science or animal science or any qualified  
agricultural education course, as defined in Section 11-103.6 of

1 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, on the campus of the technology  
2 center school district if:

3 1. That course is offered on the campus of a public school  
4 offering secondary level education that is within the boundary of  
5 the technology center school district;

6 2. The course offered on the campus of the public school is  
7 taught by a teacher certified in agricultural education; and

8 3. There is an FFA chapter affiliated with the agriculture  
9 education program of the public school or the public school has  
10 offered an FFA chapter at any time during the previous ten (10)  
11 years.

12 B. A technology center school district shall not participate in  
13 a course or courses as listed in subsection A of this section or a  
14 contest certified by a state or national FFA organization.

15 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
16 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
