6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.  
8 2011, Section 11-903, which relates to the crime of  
negligent homicide; modifying penalty; and providing  
9 an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 11-903, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 11-903. A. When the death of any person ensues within  
15 one (1) year as a proximate result of injury received by the driving  
16 of any vehicle by any person in reckless disregard of the safety of  
17 others, the person so operating such vehicle shall be guilty of  
18 negligent homicide.

19 B. Any person convicted of negligent homicide shall be guilty  
20 of a ~~misdemeanor~~ felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of  
21 the Department of Corrections for a term not exceeding five (5)  
22 years, or by imprisonment in a county jail for not more than one (1)  
23 year, or by a fine of not less than ~~One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00)~~

1 Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00), or by both such fine  
2 and imprisonment.

3 In addition to the fine or penalty, the court shall order the  
4 person to attend a driver improvement or defensive driving course,  
5 as provided in Section 6-206.1 of this title. Furthermore, if the  
6 records of the Department of Public Safety for the person reflect a  
7 conviction for any traffic offense within the three (3) years  
8 immediately preceding the conviction for negligent homicide, the  
9 fine shall be enhanced to double the amount of the fine imposed  
10 pursuant to this subsection.

11 C. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall revoke the license  
12 or permit to drive and any nonresident operating privilege of any  
13 person convicted of negligent homicide.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
