6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;  
8 amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1800.10, as last  
9 amended by Section 6, Chapter 22, O.S.L. 2013 (59  
10 O.S. Supp. 2013, Section 1800.10), which relates to  
11 the Alarm and Locksmith Industry Act; requiring  
12 certain vehicles to display name and number of  
13 licensee; requiring display of license number on  
14 certain documents; defining term; and providing an  
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1800.10, as  
18 last amended by Section 6, Chapter 22, O.S.L. 2013 (59 O.S. Supp.  
19 2013, Section 1800.10), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 1800.10 A. A license shall not be altered or assigned.

21 B. A company license shall be posted in a conspicuous place in  
22 each alarm or locksmith industry business location of the licensee.

23 C. All persons licensed by the Alarm and Locksmith Industry Act  
24 shall, on all vehicles used to transport materials and tools in the  
operation of business, display the licensee's name and the license  
number bearing the initials "OK" preceding the number. Such signs

1 and license numbers shall be printed in letters and numerals at  
2 least two (2) inches high in conspicuous places on both sides of  
3 each vehicle in contrasting color to the background surface.

4 D. The license number issued by the Commissioner of Labor shall  
5 be displayed on all advertising, contracts and bids. For the  
6 purposes of this section "advertising" shall not include uniforms or  
7 promotional items.

8 E. A company licensee shall notify the Commissioner of Labor  
9 within fourteen (14) days of any change of information furnished on  
10 the licensee's application for license or on the licensee's license  
11 including, but not limited to, change of ownership, address,  
12 business activities, or any developments related to the  
13 qualifications of the licensee or the individual described in  
14 Section 1800.7 of this title. If the licensee for any reason ceases  
15 to engage in an alarm or locksmith industry business in this state,  
16 the licensee shall notify the Committee within fourteen (14) days of  
17 such cessation. If the required notice of cessation is not given to  
18 the Committee within fourteen (14) days, the license may be  
19 suspended or revoked by the Commissioner on recommendation of the  
20 Committee.

21 ~~D.~~ F. No person shall represent falsely that the person is  
22 licensed or employed by a licensee. Any such action shall  
23 constitute a violation of the Alarm and Locksmith Industry Act.

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1        ~~E.~~ G. Each company licensee shall maintain, update and provide  
2 a record containing such information relative to the licensee's  
3 employees as may be required by the Commissioner.

4        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
