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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the State Capitol Building;
8 repealing Section 4, Chapter 253, O.S.L. 2013 (73
9 O.S. Supp. 2013, Section 19), which relates to the
10 State Capitol Building; creating Oklahoma State
11 Capitol Building Repair and Restoration Fund;
12 providing for appropriation, budgeting and
13 expenditure from fund; providing for purpose of fund;
14 providing for transfer of unused monies in fund;
15 providing for apportionment of specified revenue to
16 fund according to certain schedule; providing for
17 codification; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. REPEALER Section 4, Chapter 253, O.S.L. 2013
20 (73 O.S. Supp. 2013, Section 19), is hereby repealed.

21 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 19.1 of Title 73, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a fund for the
Office of Management and Enterprise Services to be known as the
"Oklahoma State Capitol Building Repair and Restoration Fund". The
fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year

1 limitations, and shall consist of all monies deposited to the fund
2 pursuant to law. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are
3 hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended only for the
4 purposes authorized by subsection B of this section. Expenditures
5 from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State
6 Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
7 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
8 approval and payment.

9 B. Monies in the Oklahoma State Capitol Building Repair and
10 Restoration Fund shall be expended for the repair and restoration of
11 the Oklahoma State Capitol Building upon the recommendation of the
12 Long-Range Capital Planning Commission and separate from the annual
13 capital budget as referenced in Section 901 of Title 62 of the
14 Oklahoma Statutes. Upon the Legislature's determination that the
15 repair and restoration of the Oklahoma State Capitol Building is
16 complete, any remaining monies in the Oklahoma State Capitol
17 Building Repair and Restoration Fund shall be transferred to the
18 Maintenance of State Buildings Revolving Fund established in Section
19 908 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

20 C. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, there shall be
21 apportioned to the Oklahoma State Capitol Building Repair and
22 Restoration Fund from the monies that would otherwise be apportioned
23 pursuant to the provisions of Section 2352 of Title 68 of the
24 Oklahoma Statutes, revenue derived pursuant to subsections B, C and

1 D of Section 2355 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes, a sum of
2 Sixty Million Dollars (\$60,000,000.00) for each of the fiscal years
3 beginning on July 1, 2013, and July 1, 2014. Such apportionment
4 shall be made in amounts and at such times as it is requested by the
5 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
