7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S.
9 2011, Section 29-101, which relates to fire
10 departments; requiring certain municipalities to
procure certain equipment for fire protection; and
providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2011, Section 29-101, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 29-101. A. The municipal governing body may procure
17 all necessary equipment for protection and prevention against fire
18 and provide for the organization of a municipal fire department.

19 The governing body may enact such ordinances, resolutions and
20 regulations as may be necessary to establish and operate a fire
21 department, and to borrow money and issue bonds therefor subject to
22 the provisions of the Constitution and laws of Oklahoma.

23 B. The municipal governing body of any municipality having
24 three or more state of emergencies declared by the Governor as a

1 result of wildfires or drought within its municipal boundaries in a
2 three-year-time period shall procure all necessary equipment for
3 protection and prevention against fire, including but not limited
4 to, the purchasing of dry fire hydrants and the cost to provide an
5 acceptable means of water storage for such dry fire hydrant
6 including a pond, tank, or other storage facility with the primary
7 purpose of fire protection within the State of Oklahoma.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2014.
