9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Alcoholic Beverage Laws
11 Enforcement Commission; making an appropriation;
12 stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain
13 categories and amounts; providing for the duties and
14 compensation of employees; limiting salary of the
15 Director; providing budgetary limitations; providing
16 lapse dates; requiring and prohibiting certain budget
17 practices; and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Alcoholic
20 Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission from any monies not otherwise
21 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the sum of _____
23 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
24 imposed upon the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission by
law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the
2 Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission shall budget all
3 funds in the following categories and amounts:

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
13 upon the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission by law shall
14 be set by the Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement
15 Commission. The salary of the Director of the Alcoholic Beverage
16 Laws Enforcement Commission shall not exceed _____ Dollars
17 (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June
18 30, 2015. The Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission for
19 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, shall be subject to the
20 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
21 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
22 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
23 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

1 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
2 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 (hereafter FY-15) or may be
4 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 (hereafter FY-16).
5 Funds budgeted for FY-15 may be encumbered only through June 30,
6 2015, and must be expended by November 15, 2015. Any funds
7 remaining after November 15, 2015, and not budgeted for FY-16, shall
8 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
9 year. Funds budgeted for FY-16 may be encumbered only through June
10 30, 2016. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2016, shall lapse
11 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
12 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
13 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-15, and not required to pay
14 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-16, after
15 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
16 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
17 from the FY-15 budget work program and after such revision has been
18 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

19 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2014.
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
