16 history of supporting and preserving the unique heritage and culture
17 of the state dating back to prestatehood; and

18 WHEREAS, the more than 800 archives, libraries and museums in
19 the state are the designated stewards of the culture of Oklahoma;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, archives, libraries and museums contribute to the
22 quality of life in every legislative district in the state; and

23 WHEREAS, the archives, libraries and museums in Oklahoma are
24 highly valued institutions that attract more than 8,000,000 visits

1 each year, support over 4,000 employees and utilize over 12,000
2 volunteers; and

3 WHEREAS, the archives, libraries and museums in Oklahoma provide
4 important economic benefits to each city, county and the state; and

5 WHEREAS, the archives, libraries and museums in Oklahoma enhance
6 the reputation of the state worldwide and their continued presence
7 is integral to cultural tourism programs; and

8 WHEREAS, the archives, libraries and museums in Oklahoma provide
9 affordable educational experiences for learners of all ages; and

10 WHEREAS, an engaged and informed citizenry is the foundation of
11 our great state; and

12 WHEREAS, all Oklahomans benefit from the archives, libraries and
13 museums in the state.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
15 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
16 CONCURRING THEREIN:

17 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature hereby expresses appreciation and
18 support for the archives, libraries, museums and other cultural
19 institutions in our state and applauds their efforts to preserve and
20 advance the rich history and culture of the state.

21 THAT copies of this resolution shall be distributed to the
