6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Joint Resolution relating to justice reinvestment  
8 initiatives; directing the Office of Faith Based and  
9 Community Initiatives to monitor the administration  
10 and implementation of certain initiatives and  
11 polices; providing for noncodification; and declaring  
12 an emergency.

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE  
14 1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 The Office of Faith Based and Community Initiatives shall be  
18 responsible for monitoring the administration and implementation of  
19 corrections and criminal justice reinvestment initiatives and  
20 policies developed and enacted by legislation in 2012. The Office  
21 of Faith Based and Community Initiatives shall conduct an annual  
22 evaluation on the effectiveness and impact of the justice  
23 reinvestment initiatives. A copy of the evaluation shall be  
24 submitted to the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of

1 Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State  
2 Senate.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
4 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
