6 AS INTRODUCED

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8 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State  
9 to refer to the people for their approval or  
10 rejection a proposed amendment to Section 32 of  
11 Article X of the Constitution of the State of  
12 Oklahoma; making charter schools eligible for the  
13 State Public Common School Equalization Fund;  
14 authorizing the Legislature to define a charter  
15 school; clarifying language; providing ballot title;  
16 and directing filing.

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE  
18 1ST SESSION OF THE 54TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

19 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for  
20 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,  
21 the following proposed amendment to Section 32 of Article X of the  
22 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

23 Section 32. A. For the purpose of providing buildings for  
24 school districts and charter schools as defined by the Legislature,  
there is hereby established a State Public Common School Building  
Equalization Fund in which shall be deposited ~~(1) such:~~

2 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

3 This measure amends Section 32 of Article 10 of the Oklahoma  
4 Constitution. This section creates the State Public Common  
5 School Building Equalization Fund. This measure makes charter  
6 schools eligible for monies from the Fund. The Legislature will  
7 decide what a charter school is. It changes some of the  
8 language to make it read clearer.
